Please consider this your notice and note that Arizona Revised Statutes makes the decision of public or executive session yours. Below is the wording of a portion of the statute.

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38-431.03. Executive sessions

A. Upon a public majority vote of the members constituting a quorum, a public body may hold an executive session but only for the following purposes:

1. Discussion or consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, salaries, disciplining or resignation of a public officer, appointee or employee of any public body, except that, with the exception of salary discussions, an officer, appointee or employee may demand that the discussion or consideration occur at a public meeting.

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AZ Statutes require that the Minutes of and discussions made at executive sessions shall be kept confidential except from: (1) Members of the public body which met in executive session; (2) Officers, appointees or employees who were the subject of discussion or consideration pursuant to subsection A, paragraph 1 of ARS 38-431.03; (3) The auditor general on a request made in connection with an audit authorized as provided by law; (4) A county attorney or the attorney general when investigating alleged violations of this article.
